

# Ratings Forming Part of Navigational Watch (D-Watch)



## Scope

This course covers lecture, demonstration, practical exercises, and assessments on standard bridge procedures and standards regarding watch keeping, meeting the requirements prescribed in Table A-II/4, Specification of minimum standard of competence for ratings forming part of a navigational watch, of STCW Code 2010 Manila Amendments.

## Objectives

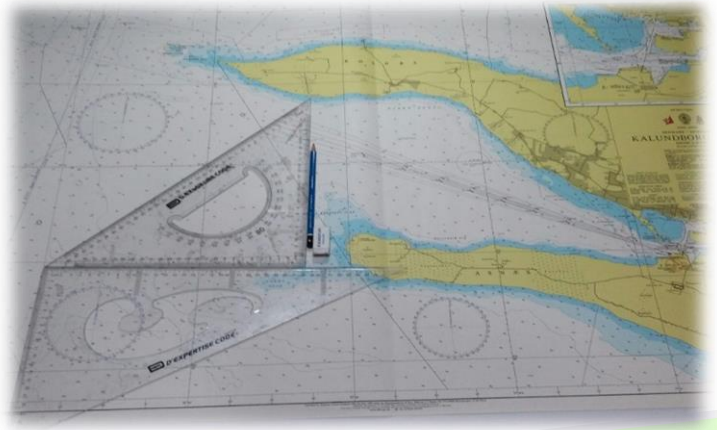
This course aims to meet the mandatory minimum requirements for knowledge, understanding and proficiency in Table A-II/4 as required in the Regulation II/4 of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended.

Specifically, upon completion of this training course, the trainee must be able fulfill the requirements of Table A-II/4 of the STCW Code which provide for competence in their actual duties and responsibilities .keep a proper lookout by sight and hearing;

- Steer the ship and also comply with the helm orders in the English Language;
- Keep a proper look-out by sight and hearing;
- Contribute to monitoring and controlling a safe watch; and
- Operate emergency equipment and apply emergency procedures.
