

Security Awareness Training & Seafarers with Designated Security Duties with COP

Aims

This training course aims to provide specific knowledge and appropriate skills to those who may be designated to perform particular duties and responsibilities to maintain security of ship, as defined in section A-VI/6-2 of the STCW Code (2010) and in accordance with the requirements stipulated under ISPS Code.

Specifically, this course will provide the participants the required standard of competence to contribute to the enhancement of maritime security through heightened awareness, recognition of security threats and how to respond appropriately, enabling them to undertake their assigned duties under the Ship Security Plan (SSP), if any.



Objective

Those who will successfully complete this course will have knowledge of relevant rules and regulation on International Maritime Security, knowledge of past and current security threat and pattern and be able to undertake their designated duties and responsibilities, as defined in section A-VI/6-.2 of the STCW Code and the ISPS Code, which include, but are not limited to:

1. Maintaining the conditions set out in a ship security plan;
2. Recognizing security risks and threats;
3. Undertaking regular security inspections of the ship;
4. Ensuring proper usage of security equipment and systems, if any.
